Getting Involved

Certain volunteer roles will have a set regular weekly/monthly schedule. These schedules are set up at the beginning of each term. Other volunteer roles will have opportunities that are flexible and you can sign up according to your availability.

Volunteer Newsletter

Each newsletter will contain information about upcoming SANQC volunteer opportunities, events, projects, important reminders and community volunteer opportunities.

Signing up for Opportunities

When there are opportunities that you are eager to participate in you must sign up for them then wait for the Volunteer Coordinator to confirm your spot for that activity. Certain opportunities are first come-first served. There is no maximum number of activities that you can sign up for as long as there are available slots. It is preferred that you sign up for a minimum of one hour time slots.

Incentive Program Volunteer Points

SANQC offers a points-reward system for volunteers. For every volunteer opportunity you complete, you will collect points. You can then redeem those points for a variety of great prizes.

Collecting Points

You will receive volunteer newsletters with upcoming volunteer opportunities. Each opportunity will have a point value assigned to it. You'll then sign up for the opportunities that you'd like to do. Once the Volunteer Coordinator confirms that you'll do that activity and you complete it, those points will be added to your total. There are even some opportunities that are worth double or even triple incentive points! Please remember that you are responsible to track your own volunteer hours through the online tracker provided.

Redeeming Points

Now you have collected your points, you are ready to get some free stuff. You can redeem your points as long as you are a current student. We can distribute prizes throughout the term, or you can save them up for a really great item. We will let you know when the last day to redeem points for the Fall and Winter terms is, otherwise your points will roll into the following term. All points will expire on Mon, Jun 23, 2025 so make sure you redeem them before then so that you do not lose them. Send an email to <u>lin.wang@norquest.ca</u> for the updated prize list.

Appreciation Prizes

We would like to celebrate your volunteer contribution milestones by entering you for an appreciation prize each term depending on the points you earned for that specific term. Your entry is automatic and doesn't use your points. The milestones happen at 10, 20 and 30 points. Your points will be added up each term to determine which milestone you have reached and for which appreciation prize you will be entered in. The bigger the milestone, the BIGGER the prize!

Certificates

At the end of your volunteer experience you can request a certificate for the time you spent with us. You can use this in your portfolio, on a resume or on your wall because you are so proud! Request a certificate at least 1 week in advance and we will have it ready before you depart for new adventures.

Volunteer Award

All volunteers who have undergone the volunteer orientation and have completed at least one volunteer opportunity in any volunteer role are eligible to apply for the \$500 Volunteer Award for each of the Fall and Winter terms. The award is anonymously scored and is based on contributions to volunteerism, leadership, and personal growth. This award is issued through SHINE.





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
